ORGANIZATION

The organization will be governed by the elected officers to be known as the Executive Board. The Mount Hermon Park shall be divided into several Area Representatives appointed by the Executive Board (Area Representatives are not on the Executive Board). It will be the duty of the Area Representative to be the contact person in their area.

OFFICERS

The officers of this organization shall be President, Vice President, Secretary, and Treasurer and others as needed to be elected for a term of 2 years and they may serve multiple terms. The President and Secretary will be elected the first year and the Vice President and the Treasurer on the second year with terms beginning at the close of the annual meeting at which they were elected. A Nominating Committee shall be appointed by the Executive Board whose duty will be to nominate one or more candidates for each office. Election of officers shall take place at the annual fall general meeting.

MEETINGS

There shall be a general meeting each fall for the purpose of electing officers. Additional meetings and social functions to be held during the year will be determined by the Executive Board.

RULES OF ORDER

Robert's Rules of Order shall govern the business proceedings of this organization.

VACANCIES

Vacancies shall be filled by a majority vote of the Executive Board.

AMMENDMENT OF BY-LAWS
